



Which school(s) does your child attend?


Overall, students' access to cell phones during the school day has an impact on their focus and engagement.


How often does your child report using their phone or smartwatch during class time?


Do you believe there are benefits for your student to use a cell phone during the school day?


If yes, indicate below which benefits are supported by student cell phone use during the school day:


Which of the following do you believe can result from student cell phone use during the school day?




Cell phones are necessary to ensure student safety during the school day.


Cell phones are necessary for students traveling to and from school.










If yes or maybe, which type of wearable do you support including?




